



# General terms

## Team

The contest is open to primary school and high school students. Contestants have to form a team which consists of up to three students. Each team needs to be led by a coach (parent or teacher) or a leader (one of the team members). Every contestant shall compete only once in each category.

## Categories

- Custom project
- Robotic challenge
- Racing

In the category Custom project, teams are divided according to their school into two subcategories (primary school and high school) and do not compete with each other. All team members in the primary school category must come from a primary school. Teams with older students will compete in the high school category. Due to time and space constraints, each category has a limited number of competing teams.

The limits for the individual categories are:

- Custom project - 12 primary school and 12 high school teams
- Robotic challenge - 18 teams
- Racing - 70 teams

## Robot models

Each robot has to be unique. It is not permitted to share the same robot with other teams nor present the same robot in multiple categories. The jury may disqualify a team in such a case.

## Contest area

The contest takes place in classrooms of Gymázium, Alejová 1, Košice. Every team will be provided a working area with a table and chairs. Some extension cords will be provided by us, but we highly recommend to bring your own. The Internet connection will not be provided due to technical reasons. The racing track is located in the sports hall of Gymázium, Alejová 1. The surface of the racing track is wooden floor.

## Terms of the contest

Each team must fill in the registration form. The registration is done at the IT Academy website. The registration link can be found on our website. After successful registration, you will receive an email with the instructions.

By taking part in the contest you agree with being recorded on audio and video tracks. This audio-video material will be used solely for propagation purposes of RBA. For this purpose, you also give us your consent to use all the submitted digital documents.

The contest is free of charge. Some refreshment will be provided in the venue. Accommodation and lunch is at your own expenses. Further information will be available in May.

## Language of the contest

The contest takes place in Slovak and English language. Usage of other languages is possible upon an agreement.

## Organization of contest

The contest is organized by Gymázium, Alejová 1, Košice in a cooperation with Faculty of Sciences of Pavol Jozef Šafárik in Košice.

# Original:

## General rules

### Team

The Team consists of no more than three people which are members of secondary school or high school. Every team must have a coach or a leader. Coach can be a parent or a teacher and the leader can be any team member. Teams can not have the same team members if they compete in the same category.

### Categories:

- Vlastný model (introduce your idea)
- Robotic challenge
- Racing

In category Vlastný model (introduce your idea) teams are divided according to their school into two subcategories (secondary school and high school) and do not compete with each other. Team competing in secondary school subcategory must have all team members from secondary school. Other teams will compete in high school subcategory. Same rule is used for setting race track in racing category. More info about individual categories can be found in rules for each category. Due to time and space constrain every category has a limited number of teams which can compete.

Limits for individual categories:

- Vlastný model (introduce your idea) - 12 teams from secondary school and 12 teams from high school
- Robotic challenge - 18 teams
- Racing - 70 teams

### Robot models

Every robot in the competition has to be unique. It is not allowed to share the same robot with other teams and present the same robot in multiple categories. Judges can disqualify a team in a case of them breaking the rules.

## Competition area

Competition is organized in classrooms of grammar school Gymázium, Alejová 1, Košice. Every team would be given a working area consisting of a table and stools. An extension cord would be provided in the gymnasium but we highly recommend to take your own. Internet connection would not be provided due to technical difficulties. The racing track is located in the gymnasium and its surface consist of a wooden floor.

## Competition terms

Every team must fill in a registration formula. Registration is done on IT akadémia webpage. You can find a registration link on our page. After successful registration an email with instructions will be sent to you.

By participating in the competition you agree with being captured on audio and video. This audio and video would be used in future propagation of the competition. You also give us an approval to use all digital documents.

Competition is free of charge and refreshment will be provided. Accommodation and lunch is on your own expenses. More information will be available in May.

## Competition language

Competition is organized in Slovak and English languages. Usage of different language is an option after an agreement.
